Ancient Rome

Presenters: Dr. John Heineman, Dr. Helen Heineman and Dr. Erika Schneider

By studying the interplay of history, art and architecture, and the literary inspiration these inspired, our team will present an integrated examination of the world of Ancient Rome, running from 21 April 753 BC (the traditional date for the founding of the city of Rome) through its ultimate triumph as the dominant empire of Europe (under Constantine the Great 272-337).

The history lectures will follow the traditional chronological order, covering such topics as the creation of the Republic, the rise and fall of Julius Caesar, the creation of the Empire by Augustus, the expansion of the Empire in both the East and West, and finally the growing crisis of its over-extended borders.

Professor Schneider's presentations will run in tandem with this progression and examine Roman accomplishments in architecture and sculpture, as well as the painting preserved at Pompeii and Herculaneum. Professor Helen Heineman will lead us through an analysis of the impact of Rome's continuing influence by a close textual reading of Shakespeare's Julius Caesar — an appropriate homage in this the 400th anniversary of William Shakespeare's death.
