


Setup Instructions continued

Before you return your Roku:

- If you wish to erase your wireless settings on the Roku:
 - Go to the home screen
 - Select:
 - => Settings
 - => System
 - => Advanced System Settings
 - => Network Connection Reset
 - => Reset Connection
- Make sure all of the components are back in the case
- Return the device to staff at the Circulation Desk



Get to know your Roku



- A **MIC** Microphone for voice search
- B **BACK** Return to previous screen
- C **HOME** Return to Roku home screen
- D **UP or DOWN** Move up or down: **LEFT** or **RIGHT** Move left or right
- E **HEADPHONE JACK** Plug in headphones here
- F **VOLUME +/-** Increase/decrease the volume of your headphones
- G **OK** Select an option from a menu
- H **OPTIONS** View more options
- I **REV SCAN** Rewind, scroll left one page at a time
- J **FWD SCAN** Fast forward, scroll right one page at a time
- K **CHANNEL SHORTCUT** Instant access to favorite channels
- L **VOICE SEARCH** Use your voice to search for content
- M **PLAY/PAUSE** Start or pause playback
- N **A & B** Action buttons for gaming

Setup Instructions

Note: our Roku works only with TVs that have an HDMI port.

- Connect the supplied HDMI cable from the Roku into an HDMI port on your TV.
- Insert two AA batteries into the Roku remote, if they are not already installed. (the remote control does not need to be aimed at the Roku; it just needs to be in the same room)
- Plug the Roku power adapter into the round jack in the Roku, and then into a power source. It will turn on automatically.
- Turn on your TV, and select the appropriate HDMI input source. You should see the Roku screen.
- Set up your network connection
 - Press the Home button on the remote, scroll down to Settings, and then scroll to the right to Network.
 - If you want to establish a wireless connection, select Wireless and enter your wireless network name (and password, if necessary).
 - If you want to use a wired connection, connect an Ethernet cable (not supplied) between the Roku and your router, and select Wired Connection in Network Settings.


