COVID-19 UPDATE

Two Additional Residents Test Positive and 32 People have Recovered;
June 9 Community Hour: Shifting the Paradigm, Moving from Marches to Action

- **Two additional residents test positive for the virus, and 32 more have recovered:** The number of people in the City who have tested positive for COVID-19 is now 1,684. With 1,199 cases recovered and 96 fatalities, Framingham currently has 389 active cases. The Framingham Health Department contacts the people who were potentially exposed and the owners of the businesses or places of employment where the potential exposures occurred to inform and counsel them on the next steps (contact tracing). In addition to the active cases, the Framingham Health Department currently is following 140 residents in quarantine.
