### **\*COVID-19 UPDATE\***

**Six Additional Residents Test Positive, and 37 People have Recovered;**

*Health Department Releases Demographic COVID-19 Data;*

***\*There will be no Press Release on Sunday, June 7\****

- **Six additional residents test positive for the virus, and 37 more have recovered:** The number of people in the City who have tested positive for COVID-19 is now 1,690. With 1,236 cases recovered and 96 fatalities, Framingham currently has 358 active cases. The Framingham Health Department contacts the people who were potentially exposed and the owners of the businesses or places of employment where the potential exposures occurred to inform and counsel them on next steps (contact tracing). In addition to the active cases, the Framingham Health Department currently is following 133 residents in quarantine.
- **The City's Department of Public Health releases demographic COVID-19 data every Saturday on all confirmed Cases in Framingham since March 1, 2020:** Data includes information about confirmed cases by age, gender, race/ethnicity, fatalities, nursing homes, and residential settings.
