COVID-19 UPDATE

Since Monday, One Resident Has Tested Positive for COVID-19, and 65 More have Recovered;

Additional City Facilities to Open Monday, July 6;

New Framingham Library Service Starting Monday: Order Library Materials Online, Pick up Curbside;

****There will be no COVID-19 Release Friday, July 3, Next COVID Release to be Distributed July 6****

- **Since Monday, one resident has tested positive for COVID-19, and 65 more have recovered:**
The number of people in the City who have tested positive for COVID-19 is 1,733. With 1,481 cases recovered and 114 fatalities, Framingham currently has 138 active cases. The Framingham Health Department contacts the people who were potentially exposed and the owners of the businesses or places of employment where the potential exposures occurred to inform and counsel them on next steps (contact tracing). In addition to the active cases, the Health Department is following 87 residents in quarantine.
- **Framingham to open the following additional City facilities to the public Monday, July 6:**
 - City Hall, 150 Concord Street, will be completely open to the public, Mon., Wed., and Thurs., 8:30 a.m.-4 p.m.; Tues. 8:30 a.m.-6 p.m.; and Fri. 8:30 a.m.-1 p.m.
 - All appointments previously made with the City Clerk's office will be honored.Each facility and office will undergo appropriate cleaning, disinfecting, and trash removal each day. Per [Governor Baker's Order](#) and the [City of Framingham's Emergency Order](#), face coverings will be required for entry into any City facility. Residents are also asked to practice social distancing. Reference all open City Facilities to date [here](#).
