Since Monday, Three Residents have Tested Positive for COVID-19, and Nine More have Recovered

- Since Monday, three residents have tested positive for COVID-19, and nine more have recovered: The number of people in the City who have tested positive for COVID-19 is 1,857. With 1,621 recovered and 121 fatalities, Framingham currently has 115 active cases. The Framingham Health Department contacts the people who were potentially exposed and the owners of the businesses or places of employment where the potential exposures occurred to inform and counsel them on next steps (contact tracing). In addition to the active cases, the Health Department is following 32 residents in quarantine.
