Lunar New Year begins February 17, 2026. This holiday is celebrated widely across East and Southeast Asia from China, South Korea, and Vietnam to many other countries. In some of these countries, Lunar New Year is the most celebrated holiday of the year.

This holiday marks the beginning of the new year based on the lunar calendar. The lunar calendar begins with the new moon and usually lasts 12 months.

In some countries, the Lunar New Year is associated with one of 12 animals from the Chinese zodiac. This year's animal is the horse, so you may hear 2026 referred to as Year of the Horse.

Little Innovators Big Dreams: Lemon Volcanoes

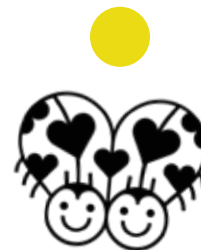
