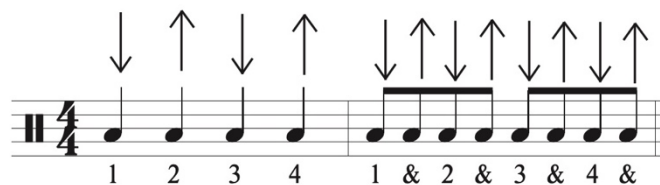
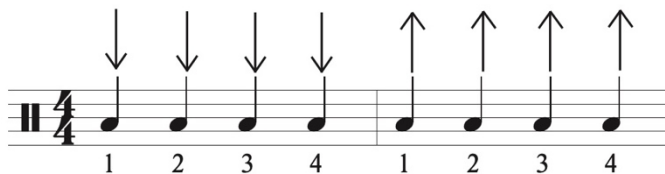

- **Strumming:**

1. Down, Down, Down, Down in Quarter Notes
2. Up, Up, Up, Up in Quarter Notes
3. Down, Up, Down, Up in Quarter Notes
4. Down, Up, Down, Up... in Eight Notes.

↓ = Downstroke ↑ = Upstroke



- **Reading Chord Progressions.**

Chord Symbol

G C D

Slashes indicate that there's no notated notes to be played and you should play the chords.

Time Signature
4/4 = 4 beats per measure

Barlines - separates measures

If a measure doesn't have a chord symbol above it, usually it means to continue playing the chord from the previous measure.
