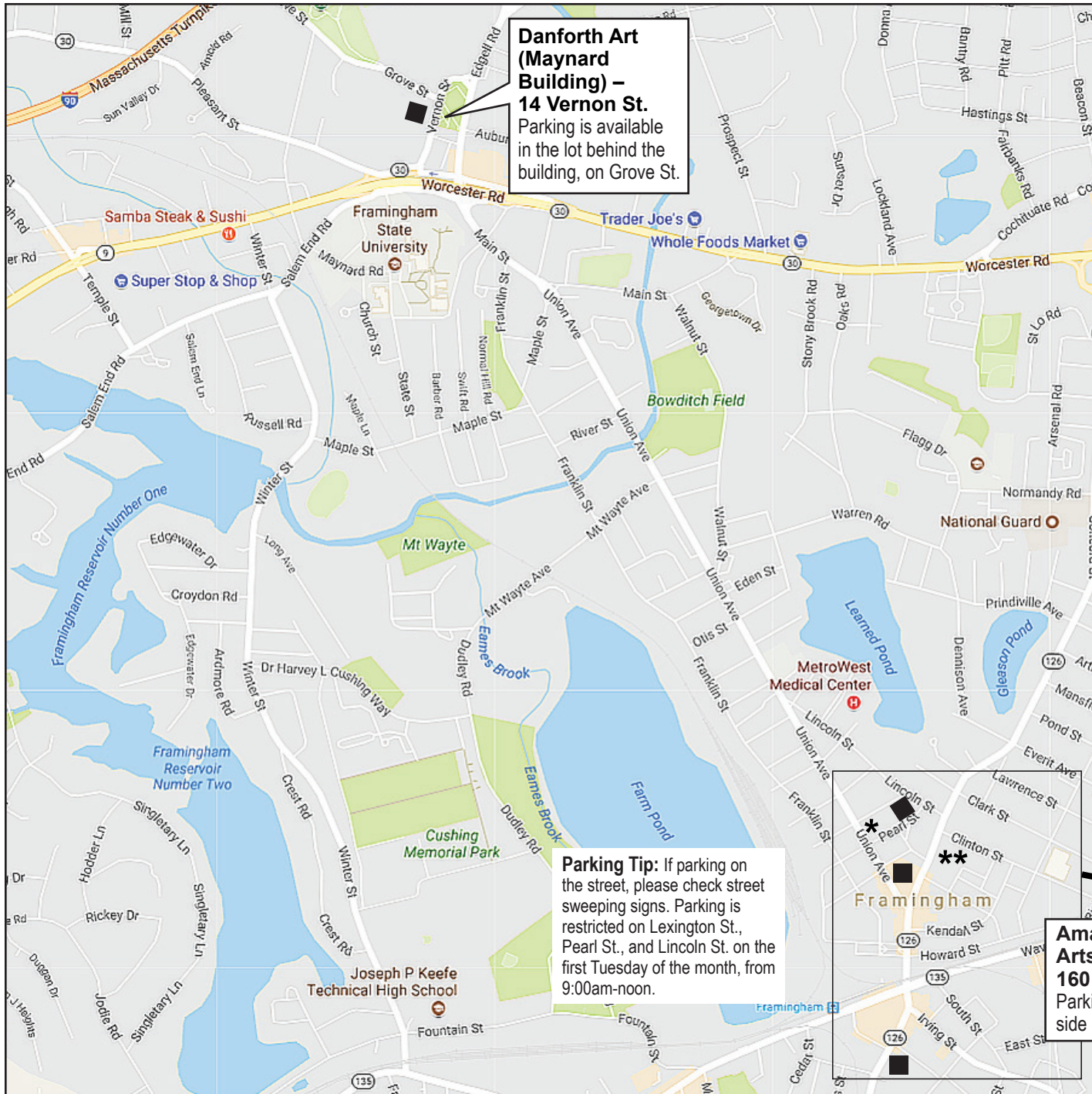


Adventures in Lifelong Learning Spring 2020 – Map of Framingham



Danforth Art (Maynard Building) – 14 Vernon St.
 Parking is available in the lot behind the building, on Grove St.

Parking Tip: If parking on the street, please check street sweeping signs. Parking is restricted on Lexington St., Pearl St., and Lincoln St. on the first Tuesday of the month, from 9:00am-noon.

Parking for Main Library and City Hall

Parking is available in the Library lot on Lexington St., in the former Danforth Museum lot, 123 Union Ave.* and at St. Stephen's School, 25 Clinton St.**

WALKING DIRECTIONS:

From Library lot to City Hall: Walk left down Lexington St. to Union Ave. and turn left (at the former Danforth). Continue down Union Ave. and City Hall and the entrance (ramp and stairs) is on the left. Inside, take a right up the steps, then go down the large staircase to the Blumer Room.

From former Danforth lot to Library: Turn right out of lot onto Lexington St.; Library is just ahead.

From former Danforth lot to City Hall: Walk left down Union Ave. and City Hall and the entrance (ramp and stairs) is on the left. Inside, take a right up the steps, then go down the large staircase to the Blumer Room.

From St. Stephen's lot to Library: Turn right out of the lot, continue to light, cross street and continue on Lincoln St. to Pearl St.; Library is on the corner.

From St. Stephen's to City Hall: Turn left out of the lot onto Concord St. and continue to crosswalk, cross street and continue to City Hall on the right. Inside, the Blumer Room is down the steps and straight down a short hallway.

CITY HALL HANDICAP ACCESS: There is a ramp at the Union Ave. entrance, and an elevator through a marked door on the back of the building, accessed by the parking lot. This door is closest to the Blumer Room.
