WHO CAN JOIN?

Anyone in 4th–12th grades who:

- Is a Framingham resident
- Have permission from their Parent/Guardian
- Have a valid Framingham Library Card (it MUST have a Framingham address)
- Have their own PC/Mac Minecraft account to play from home (guest accounts will be provided to play in the library)

Guest Accounts are available at Library Minecraft gaming events only; quantities are limited.

HOW DO I GET SERVER ACCESS?

- Fill out the Minecraft Server Application below
- Sign & date the Minecraft Code of Conduct ON REVERSE SIDE
- Return application to the Framingham Public Library either in person or by scanning and emailing it back to the teen librarian at jgarrigan@minlib.net

After verifying your eligibility, we will send you an email with instructions on how to access the server

FRAMINGHAM LIBRARY MINECRAFT SERVER CODE OF CONDUCT

1. Respect other players and be courteous
2. No Griefing (intentionally destroying or stealing other players' builds or items)
3. No swearing or inappropriate language/symbols in chat, signs, or builds
4. No bullying or harassing others
5. Do not use client-side mods
6. No spamming
7. Do not allow anyone else to use your account on the Library Server



Failure to follow the Code of Conduct will result in loss of privileges (server access):

1st Offense: 1 Week	2nd Offense: 3 Months	3rd Offense: 6 Months
------------------------	--------------------------	--------------------------

- A first offense may receive a greater loss of privileges than 1 week in some cases. Example: bullying another player is considered a severe offense.
- If your server access is suspended for the maximum time (6 months), you & a parent/ guardian will need to meet with the Teen Librarian & Assistant Director before renewal will be considered.
