About Video Conferencing and ZOOM

To join the meeting with video, download the free app and follow the prompts after clicking the meeting link just before the meeting starts. If you don't have video capability, you can just call into the meeting.

Because ZOOM has seen such meteoric usage rise due to work-at-home activity, the application has been in the Media a lot recently. There have been reports about security issues; however, these can be mitigated by using the "waiting room" feature when scheduling meetings. You should use whatever video conferencing application works for you and your student. For now, we will continue to use ZOOM for our Literacy Unlimited meetings using our paid subscription through the Framingham Public library.
