FRAMINGHAM COVID-19 UPDATE

Framingham City Hall and Public Works Closing Doors to Public Effective Tuesday, March 17, Fire and Police Stations to limit Public Access to the Minimum to meet Public Safety Needs

Framingham – As part of Governor Charlie Baker's declared emergency and growing need to protect public health and prepare City staff and systems to maintain essential functions, Mayor Yvonne M. Spicer announced today that she is closing public access to Framingham City Hall and Public Works' facilities effective Tuesday, March 17. Previously, the City announced that its public schools, Libraries, Callahan Center and Loring Arena were also closed.

Services essential to public health and safety – like police and fire responses and trash collection will continue as normal.

The city will continue to monitor the situation and reevaluate the closures regularly.
