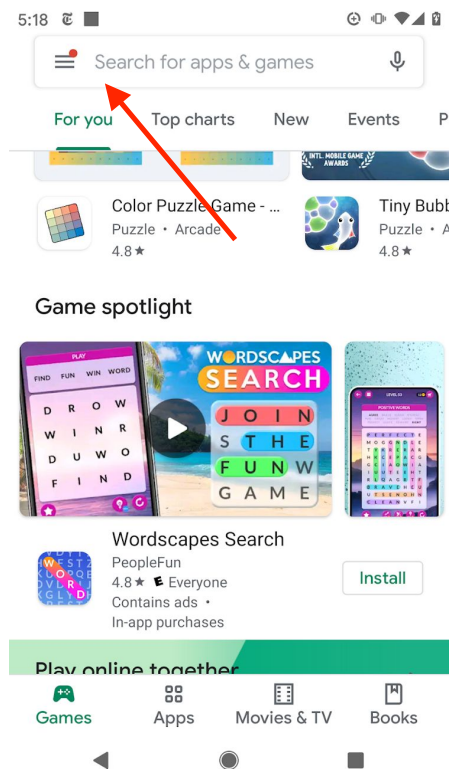
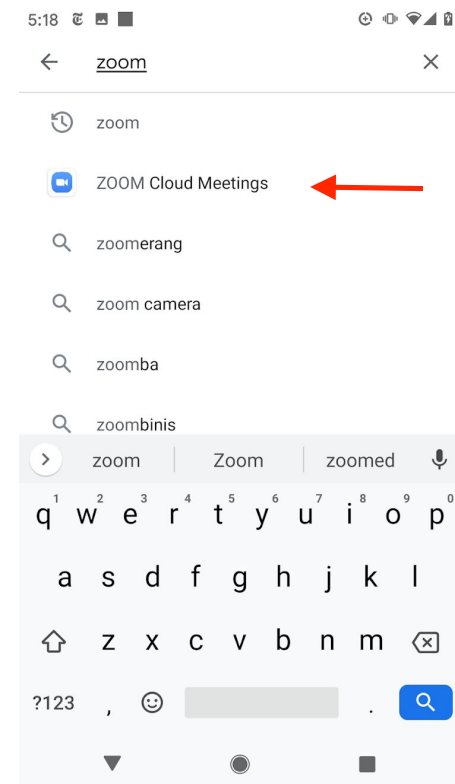


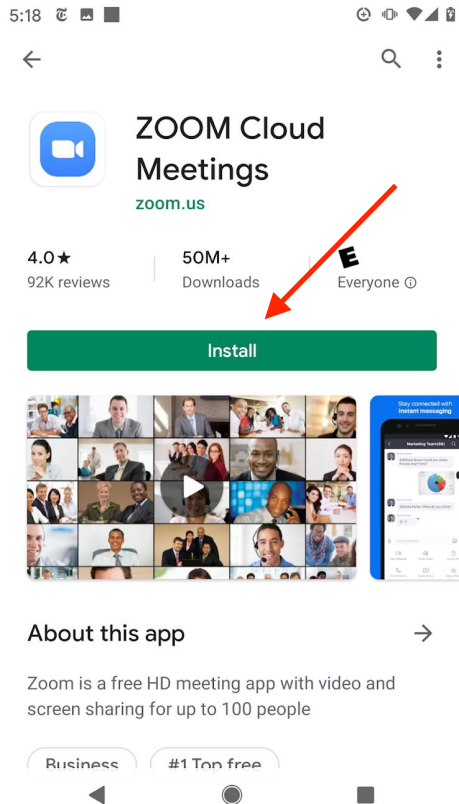
Click on **Play Store**



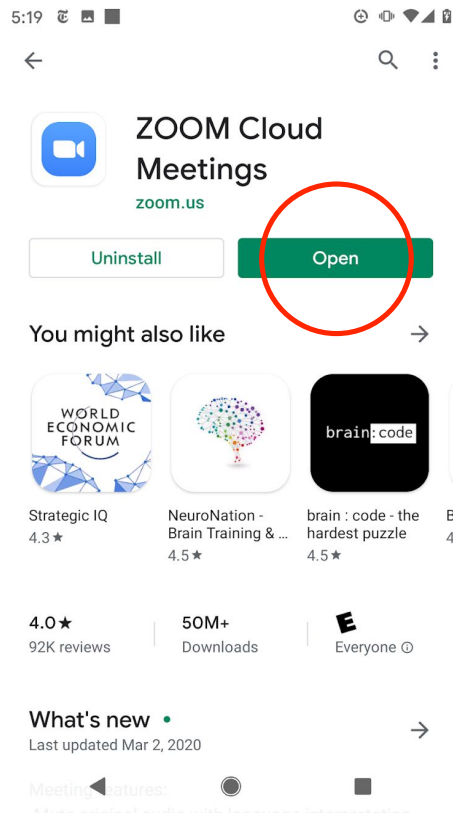
Go to the **Search Bar**



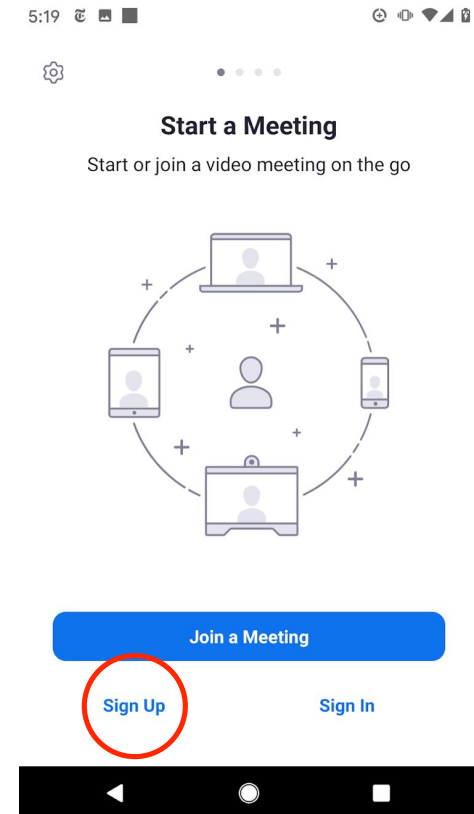
Search for "Zoom." Click on "Zoom Cloud Meetings."




Click on the **Install** button.




After the app installs, click on the **Open** button.




Now you are in the app. Click on the **Sign Up** button.

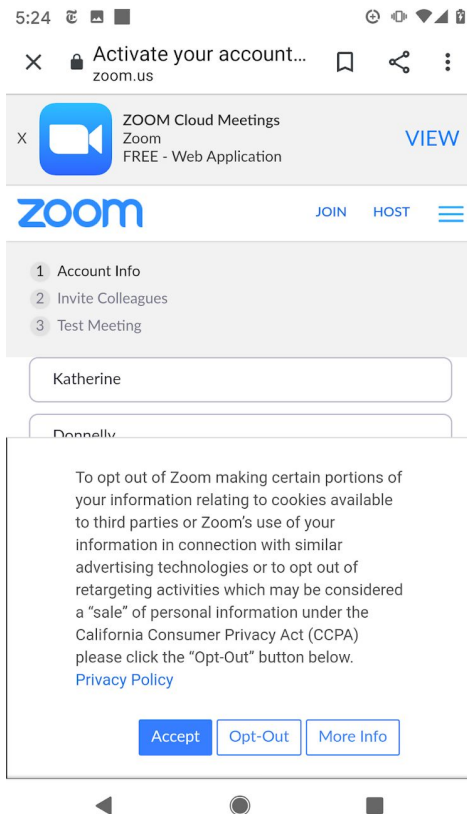
Enter your **email** and your **first and last name**. Then click the “I agree” button.

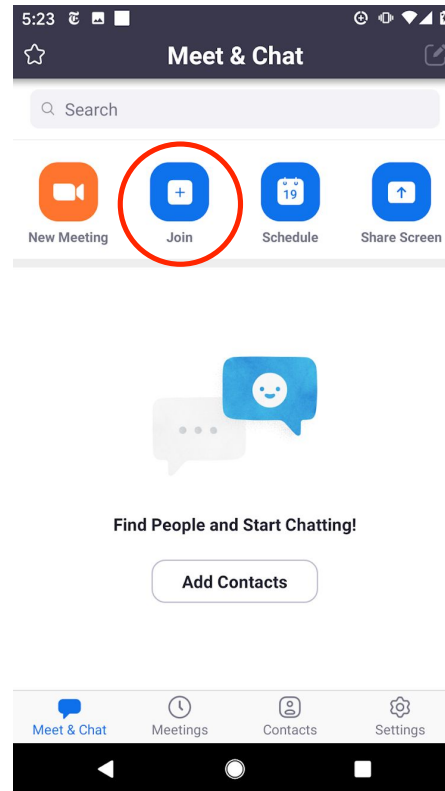

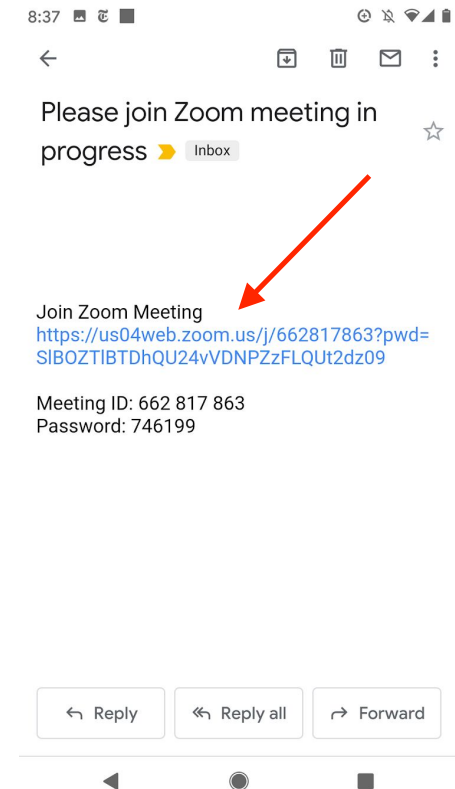
In your email, click on the **Activate Account** button.
