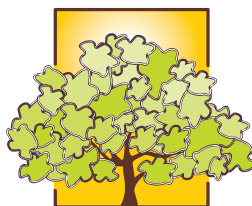


IMMEDIATE VOLUNTEER OPENING!

THE LIBRARY IS IN NEED OF A VOLUNTEER TO DELIVER TO OUR LIBRARY NEWSLETTERS AND TO OUR HOMEBOUND PATRONS FROM NOW UNTIL THE FALL.

This position requires delivery (ongoing) to our homebound patrons, as well as delivery of library newsletters once a month.

The ideal candidate should possess a warm, pleasant personality and be able to take direction well. In addition, the candidate must be a licensed Massachusetts driver with his/her own car, provide proof of current car insurance and license, and must pass a CORI check (Criminal Offender Record Information). This position requires carrying bags of books (up to 25 lbs) to deliver and pick up from the homes of our homebound patrons. It also requires delivery of library newsletters to organizations on our delivery route throughout Framingham. Volunteers should be high school graduates and older.

Please note that the candidate will be reimbursed for gas mileage at 40 cents a mile.
